## Attorney General of Jamaica and Member of Parliament

MARLENE MALAHOO FORTE QC MP is the Attorney General of Jamaica and has been a Member of Parliament since 2016. She is now a fourth term legislator who was recruited to politics directly by a sitting Prime Minister.

From her early years at the public bar, she has been highly regarded as a formidable, fair and fearless prosecutor who has had an enviably high success rate in the trial and appellate courts. Today, she continues to appear in court mostly before the Judicial Committee of Her Majesty's Privy Council in cases of high public importance for the government.

As presenter and executive producer of her own prime daytime call-in radio talk show "JUSTICE", with live internet stream, she has debated with countless listeners at home and abroad on wide ranging legal and political issues and current affairs.

She was a recipient the Hon. Justice James Kerr Award for Excellence in Public Service (2017), is named amongst the "WHO'S WHO" in Jamaica and is a past Chairman of United Way's Women's Leadership Initiative. She is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (London, England) and is a Yale World Fellow (Yale University (USA).
