



The Rt Hon Lord Justice Dingemans

Lord Justice Dingemans was called to the Bar in 1987 and was appointed Queen's Counsel in 2002.

He appeared in constitutional cases around the Commonwealth and in the Privy Council and had a wide-ranging common-law practice.

He was leading counsel to the Hutton Inquiry in 2003 and acted for the Express and Star newspapers in the Leveson Inquiry in 2011-2012.

He represented various states in ICSID, EBRD and ICC arbitrations.

He was appointed a High Court Judge in 2013 and sat in the Queen's Bench Division. He was a Presiding Judge of the Western Circuit from 2014 to 2018.

He was appointed to the Court of Appeal in 2019 and has been the Vice-President of the Queen's Bench Division since February 2020.

He was appointed as lead judge for International Relations in February 2021.

Lord Justice Dingemans played rugby union for a number of years and more recently he has acted as a judicial officer, hearing disputes about red cards and suspensions, including at the Rugby World Cup in 2019
