What is the Rule of Law?

The rule of law is a durable system of laws, institutions, norms, and community commitment that delivers **four universal principles**:









Accountability

The government as well as private actors are accountable under the law.

Just Law

The law is clear, publicized, and stable and is applied evenly. It ensures human and procedural rights as well as property and contract rights.

Open Government

The processes by which the law is adopted, administered, adjudicated, and enforced are accessible, fair, and efficient.

Accessible and Impartial Justice

Justice is delivered timely by competent, ethical, and independent representatives and neutrals who are accessible, have adequate resources, and reflect the makeup of the communities they serve.



Enforcement



WJP Rule of Law Index

- Measures rule of law in 140 countries and jurisdictions.
- Draws on surveys of 154,000+ households and 3,600+ experts.
- Reflects peoples' experiences and perceptions.
- Evaluates 8 factors, 44 sub-factors




Where rule of law is stronger, so is the **economy**






Where rule of law is stronger, there is more peace

Where rule of law is stronger, so is health












WJP Rule of Law Index 2022

What Can We Do?

Identify local rule of law priorities

Such as:

- Equal access to justice
- Election integrity and voting rights
- Trust in government institutions, especially fair and impartial courts

PNG is not yet in the WJP Rule of Law Index, but the index gives many examples of rule of law issues.





What Can We Do?

Take action to address local rule of law priorities

For instance:

- Create a task force of bar and judicial leaders to issue recommendations
- Expand legal aid efforts for low-income individuals
- Engage public and private sector leaders in upholding the rule of law and addressing justice gaps
- Collaborate with community groups on policy reform
- Educate Others. Partner with law schools and civic and cultural institutions to promote public awareness and civic engagement
